# SUNDAY September 4th, 2016 Twenty – Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### From Fr. William's Desk

These are harsh sayings of Jesus in today's Gospel. Do you have what it takes to be a disciple? Don't panic: You don't have to "hate" your family. Though Jesus' words sound as strong now as they did then, see them in terms of the rest of what he says in the gospel passage, the big message which is: Measure your resources before starting on something, like a king contemplating giving battle or a builder sizing up whether he can afford to

complete a structure. That means that we must be ready to renounce your possessions and to put our faith ahead of all else—including our family if it came to that, though it probably never will.

The issue here is our discipleship of Jesus. That is serious business, not allowing for compromises. There is something unconditional in our being claimed by Jesus. My dear friends, when a follower of Christ is called they must go all the way. When a follower of Jesus starts to hedge or bargain with God, then discipleship becomes a sham. Jesus was not fuzzy-headed about commitment. He was on the way to the cross.

The gospel passage is all about commitment. And all commitment involves some kind of cross. Parents who are deeply committed to their children make sacrifices every day, especially those who are poor. The single mother works two jobs to support her children. She gives up social relationships for lack of time and money. She carries her cross every day. As someone once said, "Commitment doesn't sit it out or sit it through." You've got to be in 100 percent!!

When I2th-century King Henry II appointed his roguish and playboy friend, Thomas à Becket, as Archbishop of Canterbury because he felt that such an appointment would guarantee his control over the church, Becket prayed in his chapel "Oh, God, I am yours now. Give me the grace to stay that way." He was later murdered by the king's henchmen. Not a bad prayer for anyone whose eyes are fixed on Jesus. September blessings from the rock!


