

From Fr. William's Desk

In his encyclical <u>Deus Caritas Est</u>, his eminence Benedict XVI wrote: "the Christian program—the program of the Good Samaritan, the program of Jesus—is a heart which sees." When Jesus says to the lawyer, "Go and Do Likewise" he is giving him and you and me some practical advice ACT like the Good Samaritan—do as he did. BE like the Good Samaritan—be the kind of person (institution) who can BE neighbor to the person in need.

This parable shows that compassion is the optic nerve of Christian vision and it also shows that some of us get that and others don't! Proust once said: "The real voyage of discovery consists not in seeing new lands, but in seeing with new eyes."

Dear friends, followers of Jesus have taken the injunction seriously—Henry Sigerist in <u>Civilization and Disease</u> writes: "The Christian faith introduced the most revolutionary and decisive change in the attitude of society toward the sick. Christianity came into the world as the religion of healing, as the joyful Gospel of the redeemer and of redemption." It addressed itself to the disinherited, to the sick and to the afflicted, and promised them healing, a restoration both spiritual and physical. It became the duty of the Christian to attend to the sick and poor of the community.

We must do likewise! How? Live compassion!!! Your neighbor is not the person next door. Your neighbor is not the family that lives in your complex. Your neighbor is not a fellow citizen, a member of your clan, your race, your kind. Your neighbor is the world.

In this story the stranger is a Samaritan, which confounds the issue because Samaritans and Jews despised each other. Jesus declares that the outsider, the Samaritan, is the hero. The one we hate is the messenger of love. The Kingdom of God knows no political or religious boundaries. As Fr. Thomas Keating writes: "There are no insiders or outsiders, no elite or non-elite. The abba whom Jesus reveals is the God of the human race as a family. Everyone must be concerned about everybody else. Unconditional love is the name of the game" Freud said the commandment, "Love thy neighbor as thyself," is the strongest defense against human aggressiveness.
