# From Fr. William's Desk

These last three sayings of Jesus are hard to take, aren't they? At face-value they are impossible to accept, let alone to put into practice. They must be handled with extreme caution, because, when taken literally, Jesus' hard sayings show that there is no such thing as a part-time Christian. We all need to pay the cost of discipleship. The

message is clear: The kingdom won't wait. A disciple, too, must know when it's time to say yes. Christianity without discipleship is always Christianity without Christ. I need you to know that I get the challenge in maintaining priorities and how difficult it can be following"

These harsh sayings of Jesus about discipleship are not meant to put us down, or lay a guilt trip on us. They may unsettle us, but that is healthy because they stir us on to more authentic discipleship. And I don't think any one of us will deny that our discipleship, yours and mine, can stand being spruced up a bit. Authentic followers don't look back. They turn forward. Elijah's summoning of Elisha comes in the midst of everyday activities: Elisha is plowing. Where do you hear God's call in your daily work? In the gospel today, Jesus begins his journey to Jerusalem. With the church, you, too, are on the road with Jesus.

Pope Francis reminds us that sometimes hearing God's call may feel uncomfortable or even a bother, but still we must persist and work toward removing barriers and opening a path to God: "The Holy Spirit urges us to undertake a more evangelical way of life . . . . It is the Spirit who makes us free with the same freedom Jesus himself lived; the freedom that makes us children of God! Do not resist the Holy Spirit!" What is one barrier that might be keeping you from undertaking God's mission in your life? Jesus continues to call others, warning them (us!) that followership is a very demanding position. Only the most sincere and dedicated need apply. Dietrich Bonhoeffer said it best...Christianity without discipleship is always Christianity without Christ.
