SUNDAY May 26, 2019 Sixth Sunday of Easter

In today's gospel Jesus offers peace, the kind of peace that the world can neither offer nor does it understand. "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you Do not let not your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." Many of us long for God's peace but our cares, worries and fears send us into a tailspin and we try to control our lives according to our wants and desires and what we see to be 'the best' answer. In the most tragic of circumstances our hearts can become deeply troubled as mine has been since we learned that Brendan has terminal cancer.

My heart is troubled and overwhelmed. There are no words to express the depth of the pain. Jesus does not condemn me for this. Rather, his heart too was troubled, broken in the Garden of Gethsemane. Abandoned by his friends, Jesus saw and took on, to the point of sweating blood, the suffering troubled hearts of all humankind, our hopelessness, our despair, our fear, our sin. He experienced and understood everything any of us could possibly go through in this life. Yet amid this unbearable suffering, Jesus chose the peace that his father offered. In that moment, in that desolation, Jesus surrendered himself totally in eternal hope, love and trust to his father. "Not my will but yours be done", he uttered and freely in God's peace he walked the road chosen for him. He walked his valley of darkness and he walks with me, with all of us, the valleys of our darkness, the valleys of our tears every day, every step of the way – to completion. Mine is a daily surrender to a loving God who never abandons me.

God's peace comes to us through his Holy Spirit and from the people and things he brings into our lives. What is the peace of God in my life right now, the peace of God that takes away all fear? The deepest peace of God for me, my consolation, is in my knowing and trusting in the promise of Jesus, the promise of resurrection, first of Jesus, and then of each of us when we die; I know that 'life is not ended but changed'. The peace of God for me is the blessing of family, near and far, as we reach out to hold the other up, to be as Christ for each other. The peace of God for me is the comfort of my Gospel Gal Sisters who are the love of God in their every gesture of caring. The peace of God for me is my Holy Cross family being God's assurance through words, prayers, actions. The peace of God for me is my non-church friends who live the love of Jesus by being there whenever I need them. The peace of God for me is the snippets of scripture, words from hymns that come to my mind unsolicited. They bring me closer to God's love and tell me Jesus is with me and when there is only one set of footprints, I know Jesus is carrying me. In this peace I walk with Brendan.

Every day, I am reminded that God's peace is in everyone, everywhere, at all times. Ours is to open our eyes, see it, claim it as our own, offer it to others and live it one day at a time. My journey, everyone's journey, is a journey of continual conversion to unbroken, sanctified oneness with Jesus knowing that he gives us the strength to endure to our resurrection.

Individual facing family difficulties / financial hardship.

Strong academic marks with experience in church, community involvement and volunteer work.

Full time student at Post Secondary institution/ college or trade school.

A practicing catholic involved in their parish community.

Scholarship: \$2000 per year. Scholarship will be renewed for up to three additional years based on financial hardship and need.

Essay: Write a one page essay (maximum 200 to 250 words) stating your career objectives, your accomplishments, your community and volunteer involvement. Tell us why you need financial assistance.
