Reflections from the Gospel Gals

"His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship is one that shall never be destroyed." *Daniel 7. 14.* That's God's promise to us. It should awaken such a sense of awe and wonder.

How loved are we that God would send his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe to share God's love with us? A love given freely; a love we know we don't deserve; a love so great we will never fully understand it. This love is what we are celebrating today on this Feast of Christ the King.

Jesus is a king like no other, "Jesus isn't a king who lives in a palace. He lives in our broken and wounded hearts." He is a King who came not to rule but to set us free from sin. He is a King, who had his sandals on the ground, walked with the lonely and the poor, and exposed God's heart for all the world to see. He is a king who teaches us to love God with all our heart and to love our neighbor as our self. He is a King whose throne is the cross.

We were brought into this kingdom on the day we were baptised. When the priest traced the sign of the cross with chrism oil on the crown of our heads and said, "As Christ was anointed priest, prophet, and king, so may you live always as a member of his Body, sharing everlasting life." This is our story.

In the very last line of today's Gospel, Jesus says, "Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." I have been thinking about these words and what they mean to me. Do I listen, or am I like James and John in Mark's Gospel? They listened to Jesus' voice and yet got the message wrong? In my daily life, do I pick and choose my own version of His truth as I see fit?

On this Feast of Christ the King, let's ask ourselves how we live His truth. Do we keep Jesus in the corner of our lives and only bring him, front and center on Sundays, or when we need his help? Or, do we live our days as a prayer giving thanks for all our blessings, listening to Jesus' voice within and being moved, by the Holy Spirit, to take that love out to our brothers and sisters. Jesus modelled for us how we are to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, visit the sick and those in prison. This was his 'to do' list, and He has passed that list on to us. So, how are we doing with His list? We can't say we forgot it, or it's sitting on the kitchen counter, because His list is stamped on our hearts. In the bible is says, "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." God has a plan for us, all of us! How do we find out about that plan? We ask His Son.

As we celebrate today's feast let's nourish our souls with prayer, with community, with reconciliation, with the Eucharist. And as we enter our Advent Season next week, let us remember that our Lord sits as King, forever. Jesus' Kingdom is all about love, truth, compassion and peace. If we truly understood how much God loves us, our lives would be transformed, our hearts would be overflowing with joy through the power of Christ the King.

"I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come." God's love,
